Start 1991, still with Deutscher Fernsehfunk, followed by Sender Freies Berlin, FAB and from 1993 until 2000 she spread her high spirits at Sat1 „Frühstücksfernsehen“ (a morning show).

With her cheerful and straightforward nature she became then, until 2007, most notably the distinctive face of ZDF Fernsehgarten, where she also set records!

Even a world record!! With Kai Böcking, Andrea Kiewel presented the longest online show of the world - 26 hours – and many important music shows such as the „ABBA Jubilee Gala“.

And as she simply could talk to everybody she also hosted since 2007 for the MDR „Riverboat“ and writes a steady column for „Super-IIIu“.

It's evident that as a family person she still found time in-between for 2 children and three husbands!

It's evident that she quickly had to write a book about, bearing the clear title „Mama, Du bist nicht der Bestimmer“! (Mom, you're not the Decider).

Then, last year Andrea Kiewel unfortunately thwarted herself.
